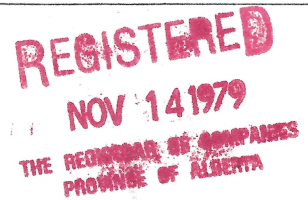
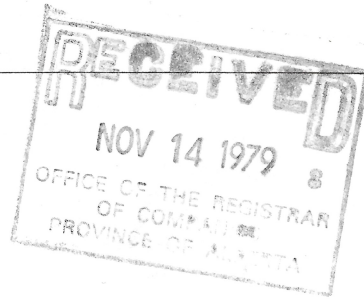

WE, the undersigned, hereby declare that we desire to form a society under The Societies Act, R.S.A. 1970, and that:

1. — The name of the society is — **THE LETHBRIDGE FOLK CLUB**
2. — The objects of the society are —
